New NCARE Director General, Jordan



The National Center for Agricultural Research and Extension (NCARE) is having a new Director General, Dr. Faisal Awawdeh, effective August 2007. Prior to this, he served as Director General Assistant for Financial and Administration Affairs, Secretary-General Assistant for Livestock of the Ministry of Agriculture, and Animal Production Expert with AAAID in Sudan. Dr. Awawdeh received his Ph.D. from Washington State

University. He is a council member of several scientific, civil and professional societies, and has more than 30 scientific publications. Dr. Awawdeh envisions promoting primary role of NCARE as a platform for agricultural research and extension in the region.
